

The safety and well-being of our students and staff is our top priority. We have implemented several procedures in the Alta-Aurelia School District that will limit access to our buildings. These procedures are in accordance with the recommendations from the Iowa Department of Public Health and the Iowa Department of Education.

- We ask that parents pick up their children outside the school. Each building principal will communicate this procedure to our families
- We will suspend parents eating lunch with students.
- We will ask community partners (guest readers, mentors, no trainings in our buildings, etc.) to not come to the school until we open fully our doors back up to the public.
- All school sponsored activities will continue practice as scheduled. The spring play at the Roxy and musical at the middle school will allow two family members per student only to attend.
- If you travel to a high-risk area/state (please check the CDC website to see which states have large numbers of cases), we ask that you self-isolate and wait to come back to school.
- Students from outside the Alta-Aurelia School District will not be allowed in our facilities for team practices or events. (Club Team Practices and Group gatherings)
- If you are sick, please stay home.

This is new territory for everyone. Our Staff has been working to ensure the safety of our students. We understand that this may inconvenience people. Please be patient as we work through a very difficult time in our state and country.
